Theresa Dizon-De Vega met with Filipino students taking up Master of Laws (LLM) and Juris Doctor (JD) studies at different New York universities last 2 March as part of the Consulate's efforts to further enhance coordination with Filipino student groups and to help them establish networks and support systems within the Fil-Am community.

The students are all lawyers from the Philippines who are currently enrolled at New York University, Columbia University, and Fordham University.
