23 January 2020, New York – The Philippine Consulate General in New York and the Philippine Department of Tourism – New York hosted the launching of the 2020 Very Important Pinoy (VIP) Tour, formerly Ambassadors' Tour, on 21 January 2020 at the Kalayaan Hall, Philippine Center New York.

The VIP Tour is an annual event organized by the Department of Foreign Affairs, in cooperation with the Department of Tourism's Tourism Promotions Board and Rajah

Tours. This year's tour will feature historical places and mouth-watering cuisine in Manila, Iloilo and Boracay from 19 to 26 July 2020.

Prior to the launching event, Post, PDOT-NY, PAL, Rajah Tours and local travel agencies held a meeting at the Kalayaan Hall Annex to discuss the technical aspects of the tour package before they proceeded to attend the event at the Kalayaan Hall.
